The following scholarships are available for Williamsburg Technical College students and will be awarded based on the stated criteria. Read the eligibility requirements, and if you are eligible to apply, check the box in the right hand column. Turn in completed forms to the Student Services Office.

Scholarships	Eligibility Criteria	Check if Eligible
J.P. Askins, Jr. Memorial Scholarship	Recipient must be a first-time freshmen who has demonstrated high school scholastic achievement (must have recommendation from counselor); college student who is enrolled in a curriculum program and who is a Williamsburg County resident—priority will be given to Hemingway High School graduate.	
Dayco Scholarship	Nominee must be second-year full-time associate degree student; must lack no more than two semesters to complete graduation requirements; maintain a 3.0 GPA.	
Rotary Book Scholarship	Recipient must be a graduate of a Williamsburg County high school; enrolled as a full-time student; must maintain a 3.0 GPA. Amount: \$500 disbursed \$200 fall and spring, \$100 summer.	
Progress Energy Scholarship	Preference given to Progress Energy customer; enrolled in Electrical Technology degree program; must maintain a 3.0 GPA. Amount: \$1,000: disbursed \$500 fall and spring.	
The Exchange Bank of South Carolina Scholarship	Recipient must be enrolled full-time in Associate of Arts or Associate of Science program; have earned no less than 24 semester hours with no grade less than a 'C'; 3.0 GPA; provide two letters of support; preference will be given to Williamsburg County resident. . Will be awarded only after all other financial aid is awarded and may be used for books and tuition only (no refund checks).	
The South Carolina Early Childhood Credential Scholarship Program	Recipient must be a teacher, director, or family childcare provider working in a licensed or registered child care facility; must be enrolled in Associate of Public Service-Early Childhood; must commit to completing 9-15 hours of education a semester.	
The Williamsburg Technical College Foundation Scholarship	Recipient must not be eligible for federal financial aid but may be eligible for Lottery Tuition Assistance. Must maintain a 3.0 GPA once awarded. Amount: \$400 prorated for less than full-time attendance in the fall.	
The Firestone Endowed Scholarship	Recipient must be employed with Firestone or must be a spouse or dependent child of a Firestone employee (verified by Firestone HR). Must have a 2.5 GPA from high school or an institution of higher learning to enter and must maintain 2.5 GPA to retain. Amount: \$500 disbursed \$250 fall and spring. Will be awarded after all financial aid is awarded.	
The Henry and Jackie Poston Scholarship	Recipient must have a 2.0 GPA from high school or an institution of higher learning to enter and must maintain 2.0 GPA to retain. Amount: \$1000 disbursed \$400 fall and spring and \$200 summer prorated for less than full-time attendance. Will be awarded only after all other financial aid is awarded and may be used for books and tuition only (no refund checks).

<p>The Williamsburg First National Bank Scholarship</p>	<p>Recipient must have a 3.0 GPA from high school or an institution of higher learning to enter and must maintain 3.0 GPA to retain; must be enrolled in a curriculum at WTC; must be a legal resident of SC with preference given to Williamsburg County residents. Amount: \$1000 disbursed \$400 fall and spring and \$200 summer prorated for less than full-time attendance. Does not affect lottery eligibility but will be awarded after tuition and fees charges have been satisfied.</p>	
<p>The Mr. & Mrs. Thomas English McCutchen & Jane Perry McCutchen Scholarship</p>	<p>Recipient must be enrolled in Associate of Arts or Science program. Must have earned no less than 24 semester hours with no grade less than a C and a 3.0 GPA. Will not exceed two semesters full-time. Amount: \$1000 disbursed \$400 fall and spring and \$200 summer prorated for less than full-time attendance. Will be awarded only after all other financial aid is awarded and may be used for books and tuition only (no refund checks).</p>	
<p>The President's Award Scholarship</p>	<p>Recipient must be a spring Williamsburg County high school graduate before the fall of the year of WTC entry. Must have the highest <u>final</u> high school GPA and must maintain a 3.0 GPA fall semester to receive award spring semester and must maintain a 3.0 GPA in spring semester for consideration of summer award. Amount: \$1000 disbursed \$400 fall and spring and \$200 summer prorated for less than full-time attendance.</p>
