The purpose of the Substantive Change For Accredited Institutions Policy is to ensure that Williamsburg Technical College will continuously monitor all changes at the institution to ensure that any substantive changes representing a significant modification or expansion of the nature and scope of the institution will be reported appropriately and in a timely manner to the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (the Commission). This policy is aligned with the purpose of the President’s Office of the College.

It is the responsibility of the President’s Council(PC), the Academic Council (AC), and the Curriculum Review Committee (CRC) to follow the substantive change procedures established by the Commission and to collaborate with the College’s SACSCOC Liaison to ensure compliance and to inform the Commission of such changes in accordance with those procedures. The President’s Office shall be responsible for implementing the policy as well as compiling and submitting the required substantive change documentation to the Commission whenever a change at the institution requires notification and documentation.
